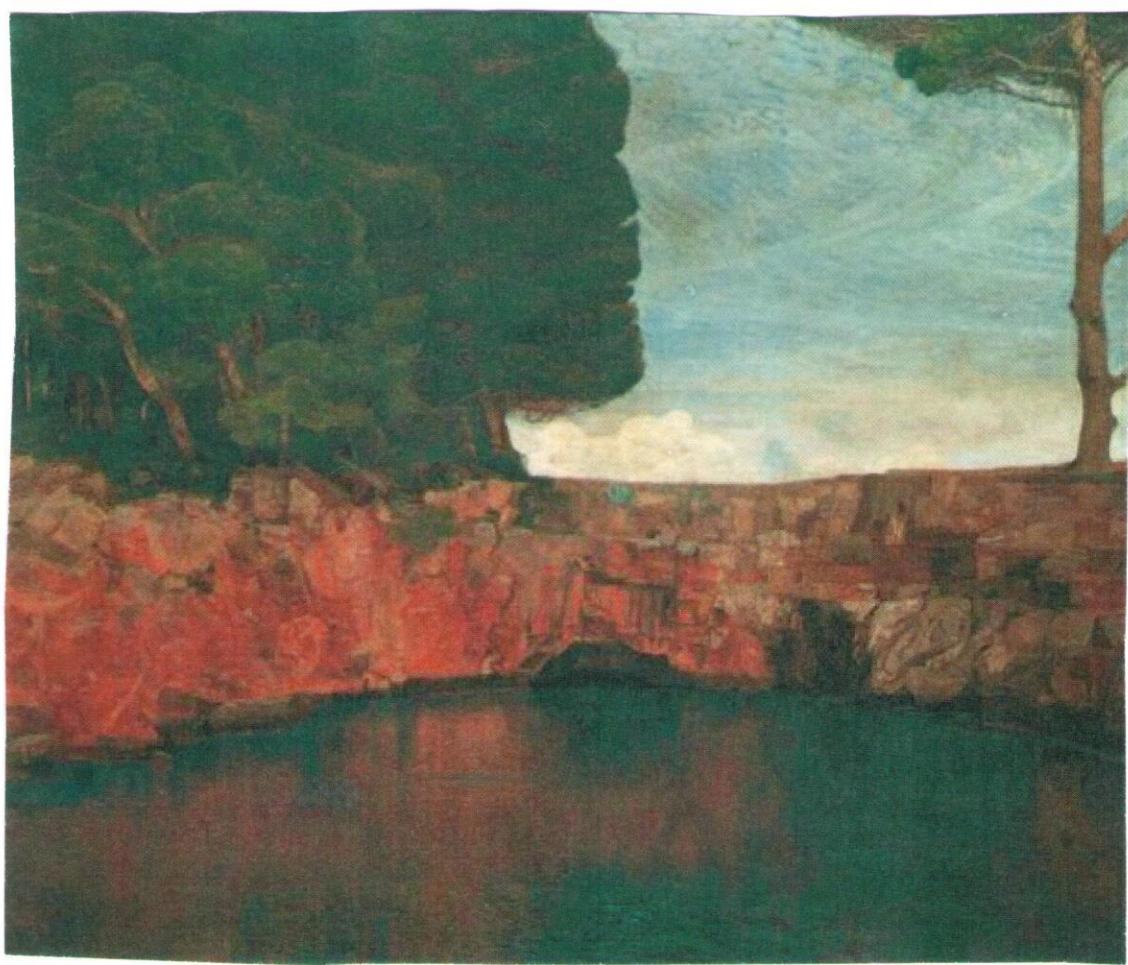


Fig. 3f) Karl Mediz, The Coast at Adria, Slovenia, oil on canvas

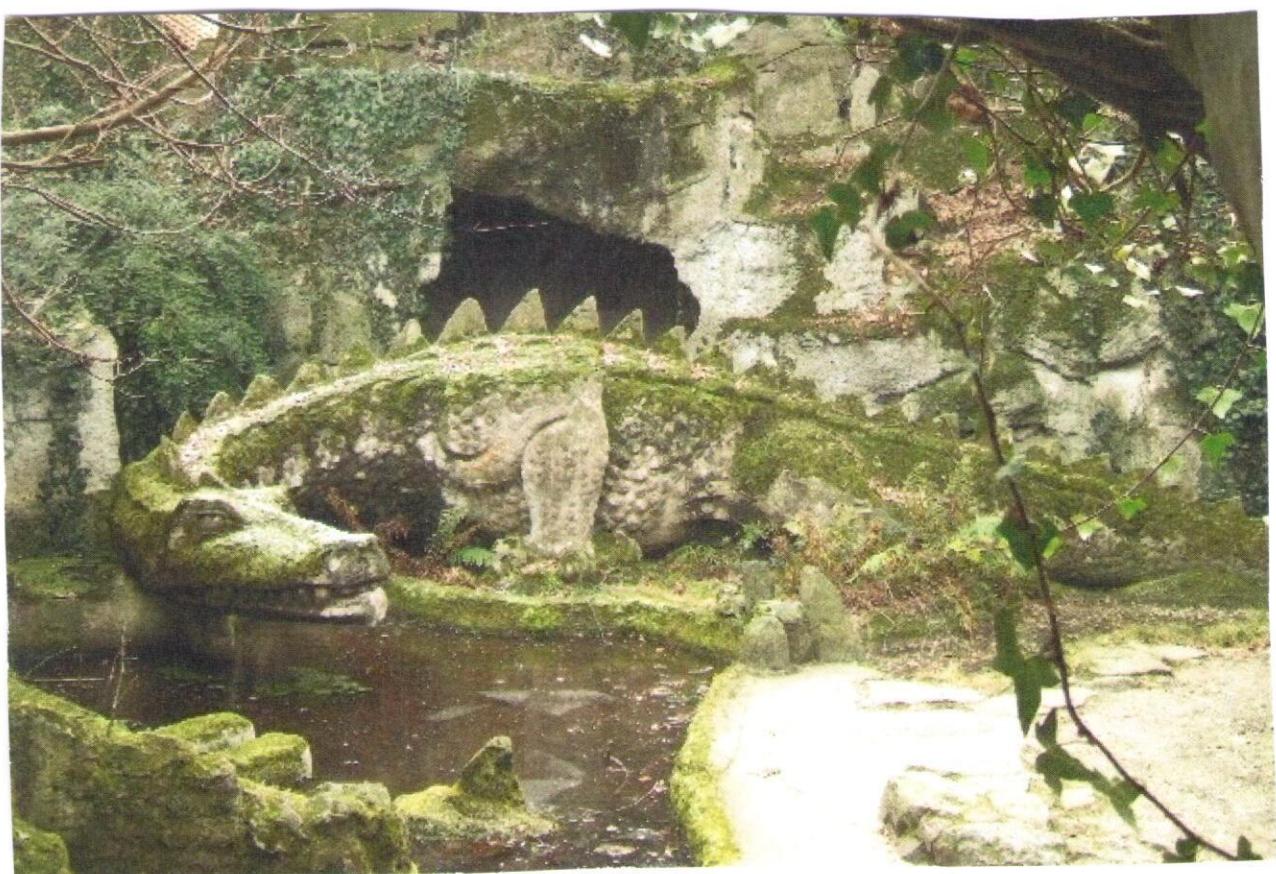
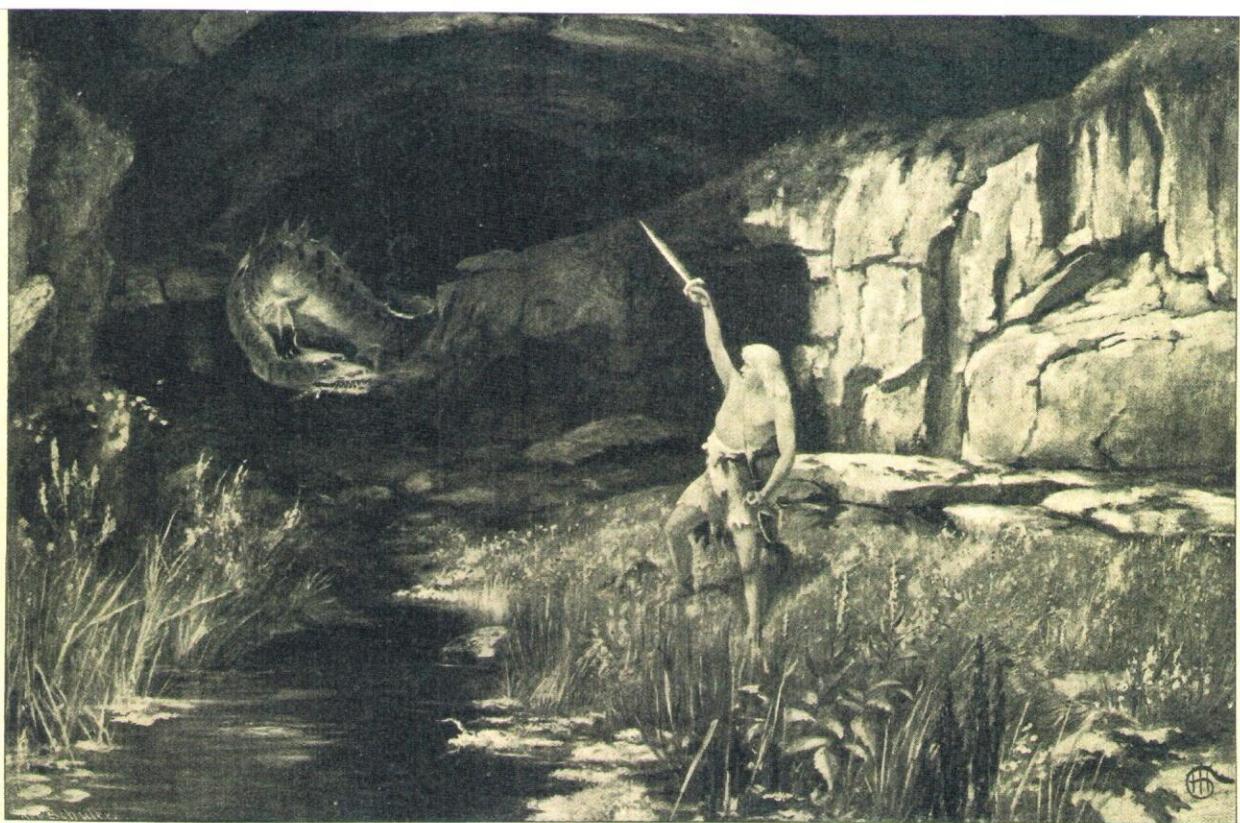


Fig. 4c) After the painting by Hermann Hendrich, Siegfried and Fafner, print, 1901

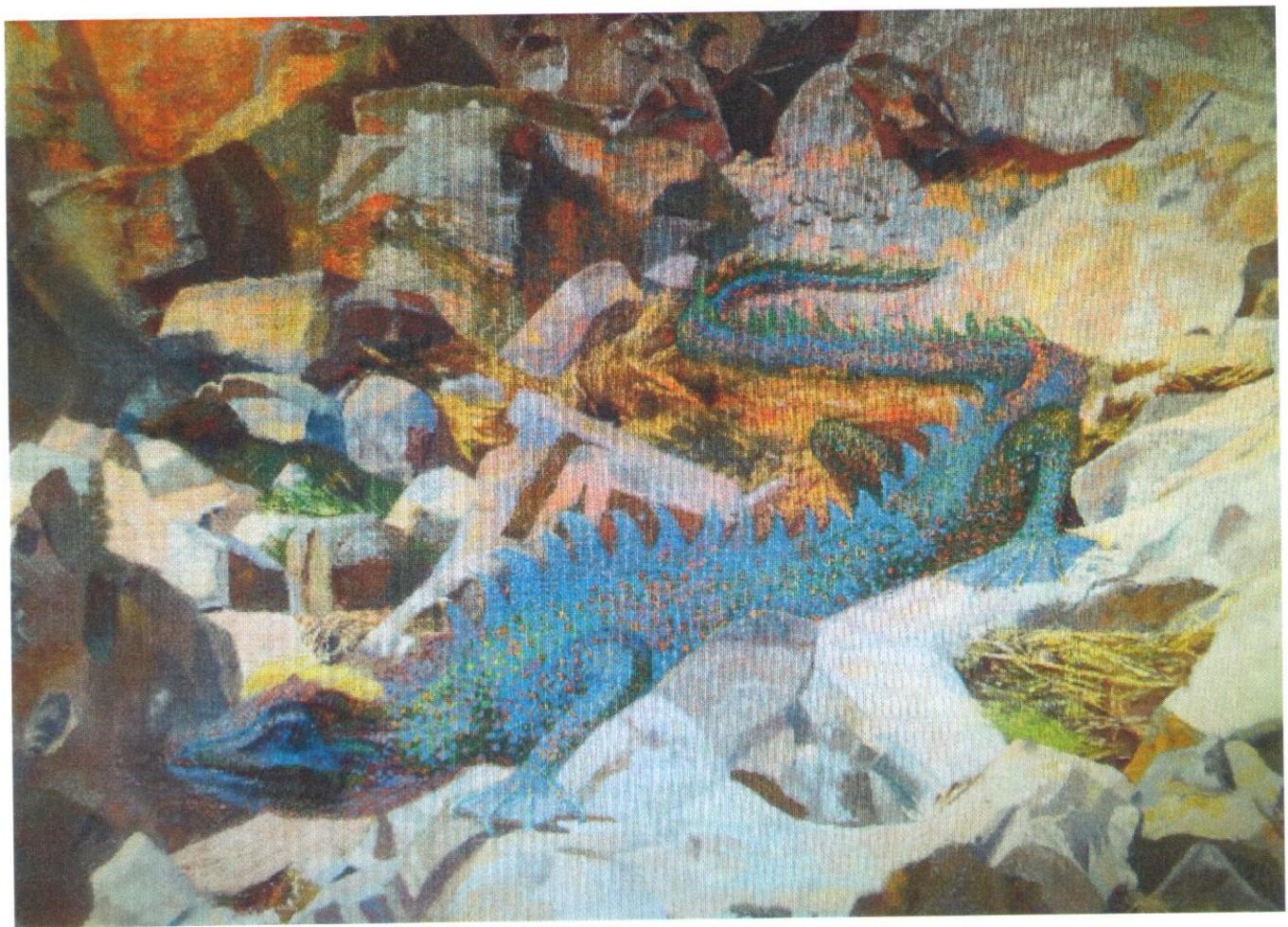


Fig. 5) Karl Mediz, The Dragon, oil on canvas, 1891, detail

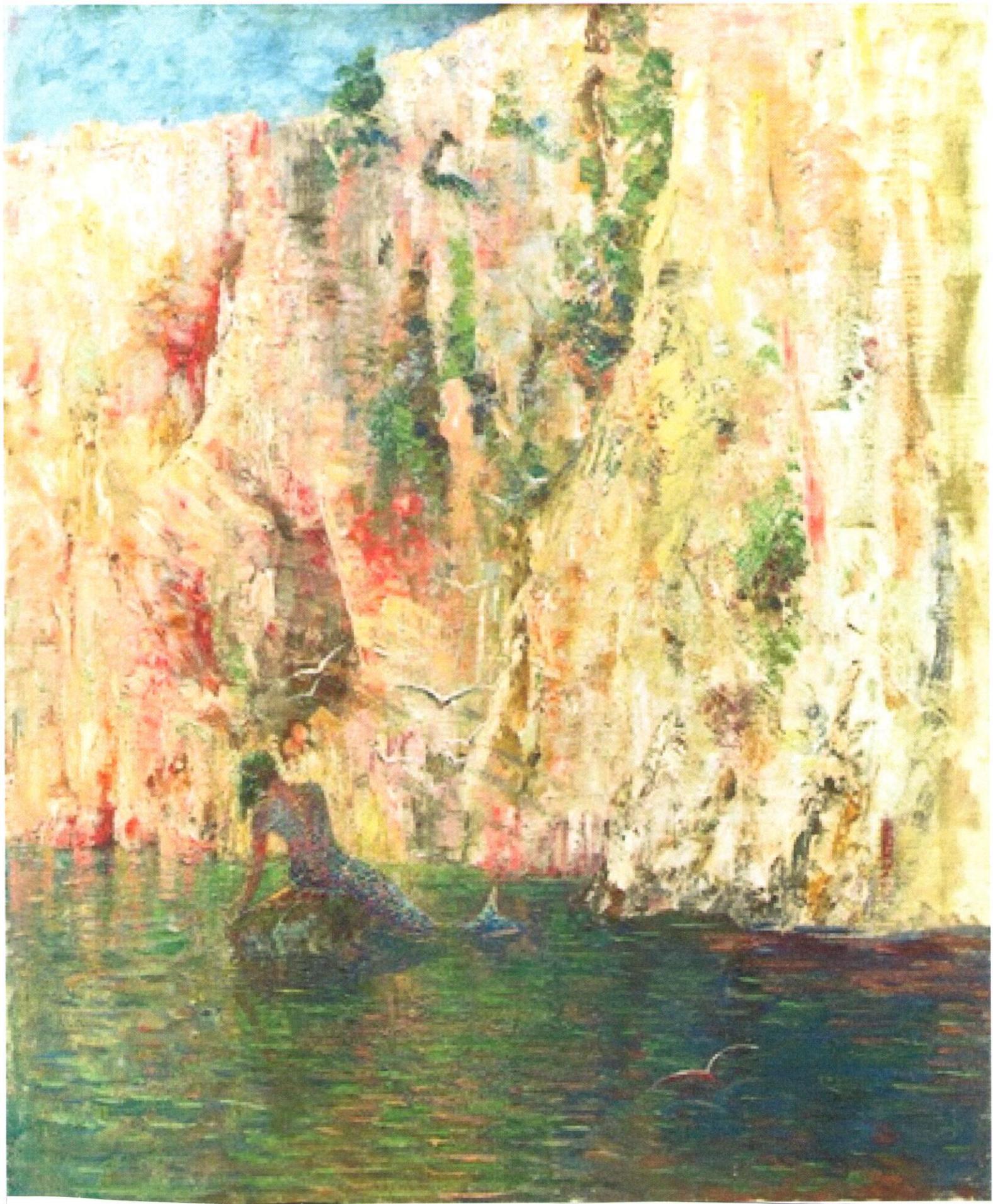


Fig. 6a) Karl Mediz, Die Nixie (The Mermaid), oil on canvas, 1891
