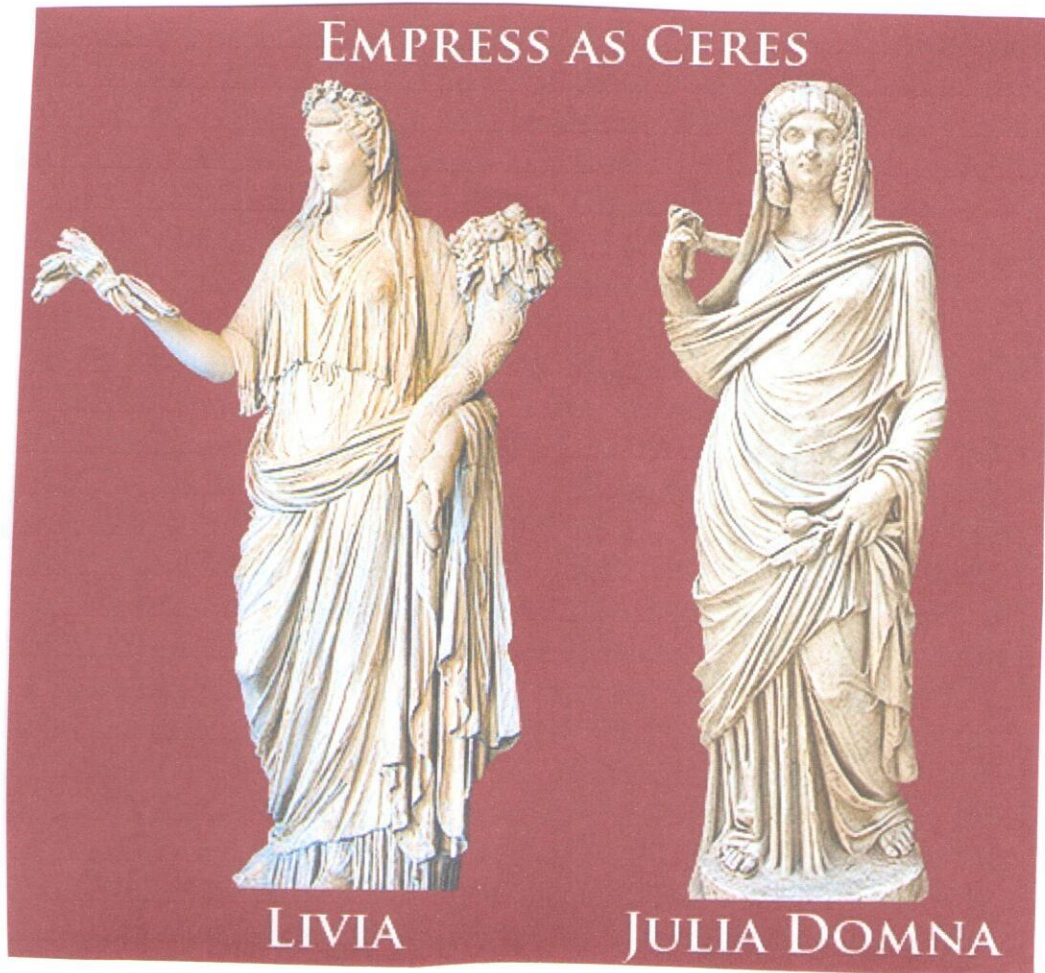


Fig. 8c) Roman Empresses as Ceres



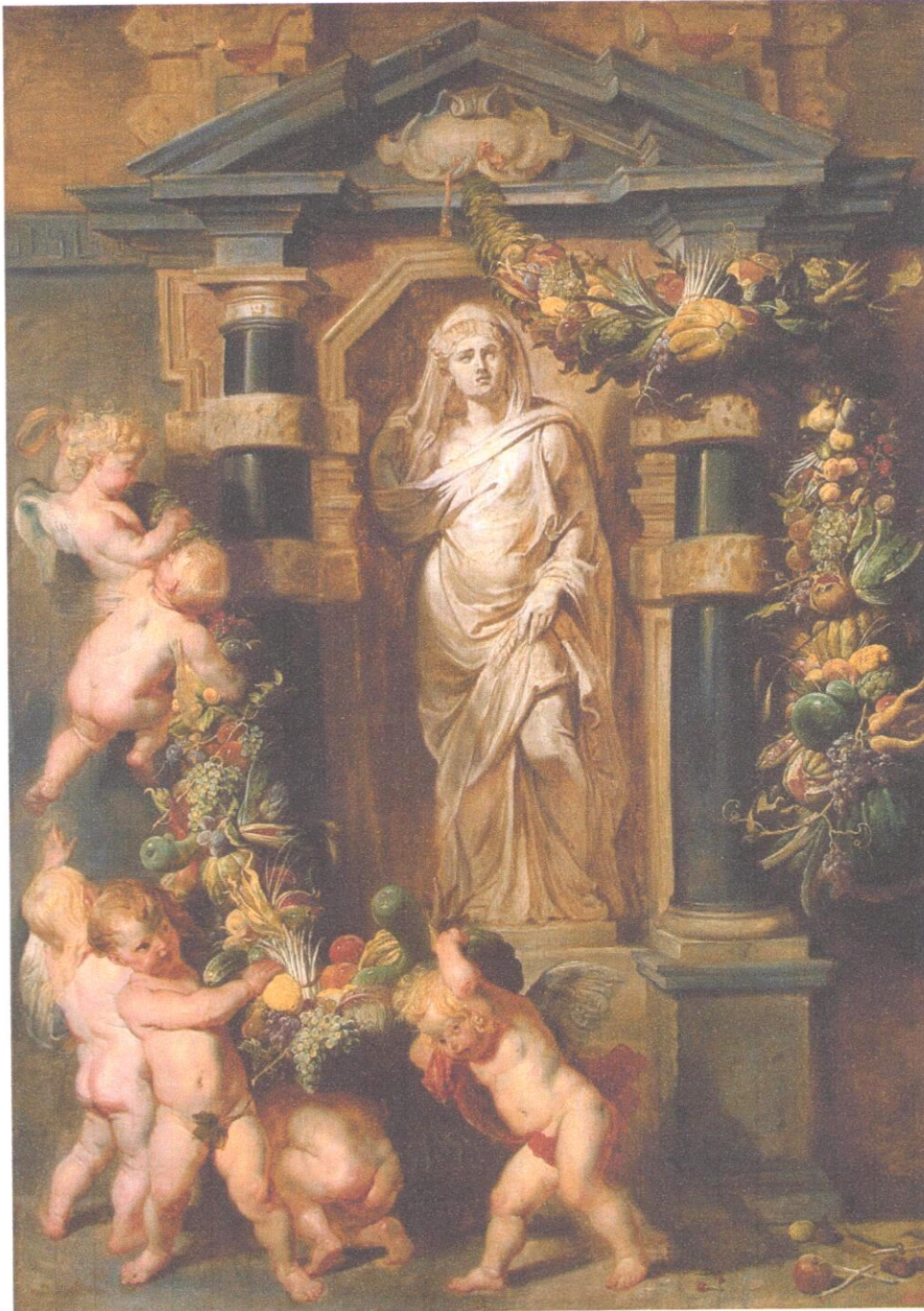


Fig. 9) Peter Paul Rubens and Frans Snyders, Roman Statue of Ceres with Cupids, oil on panel, ca. 1615, Hermitage, St. Petersburg

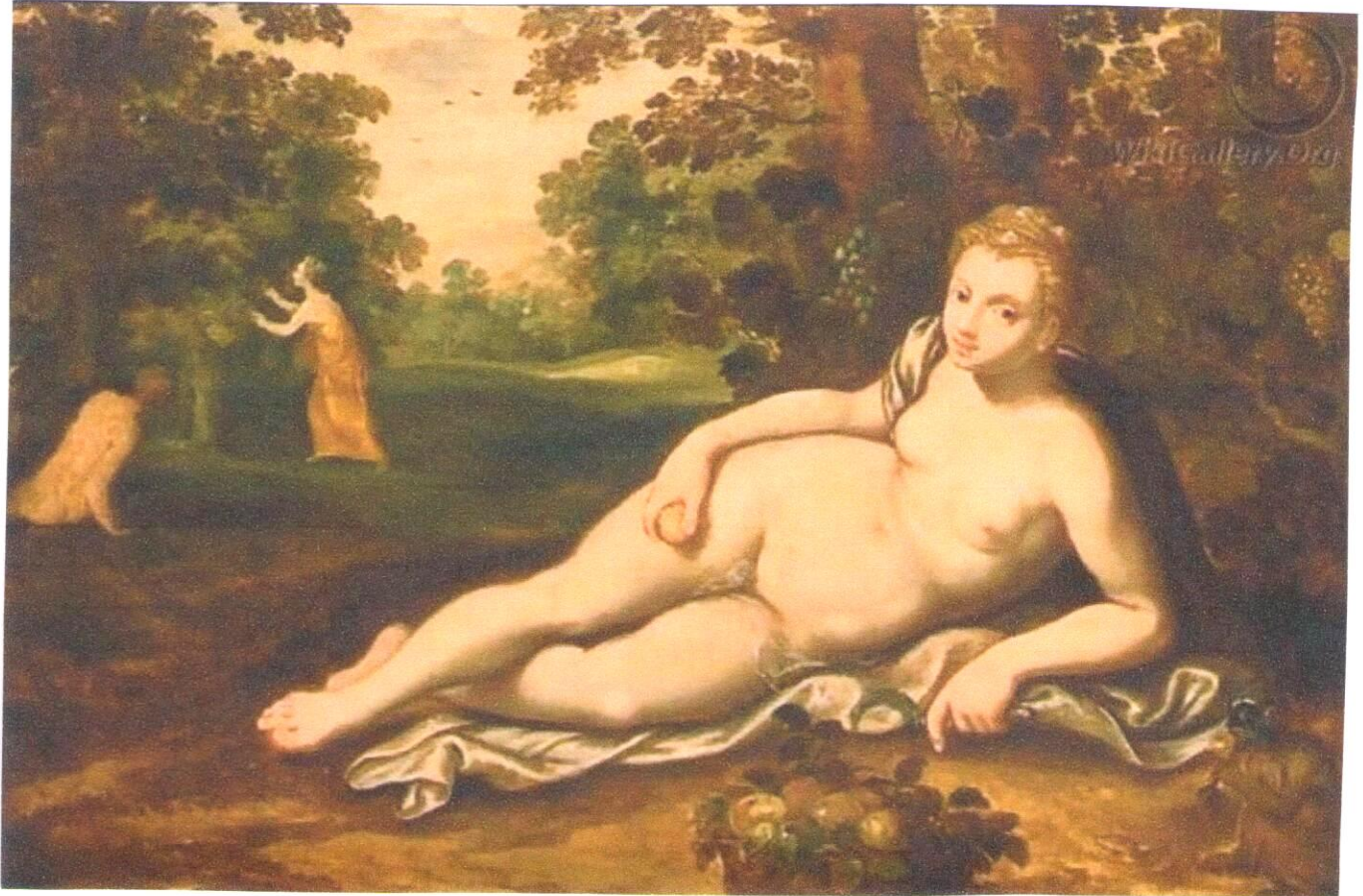


Fig. 10a) Attributed to Adriaen van Stalbeert, Reclining Ceres, oil on panel, 1660s

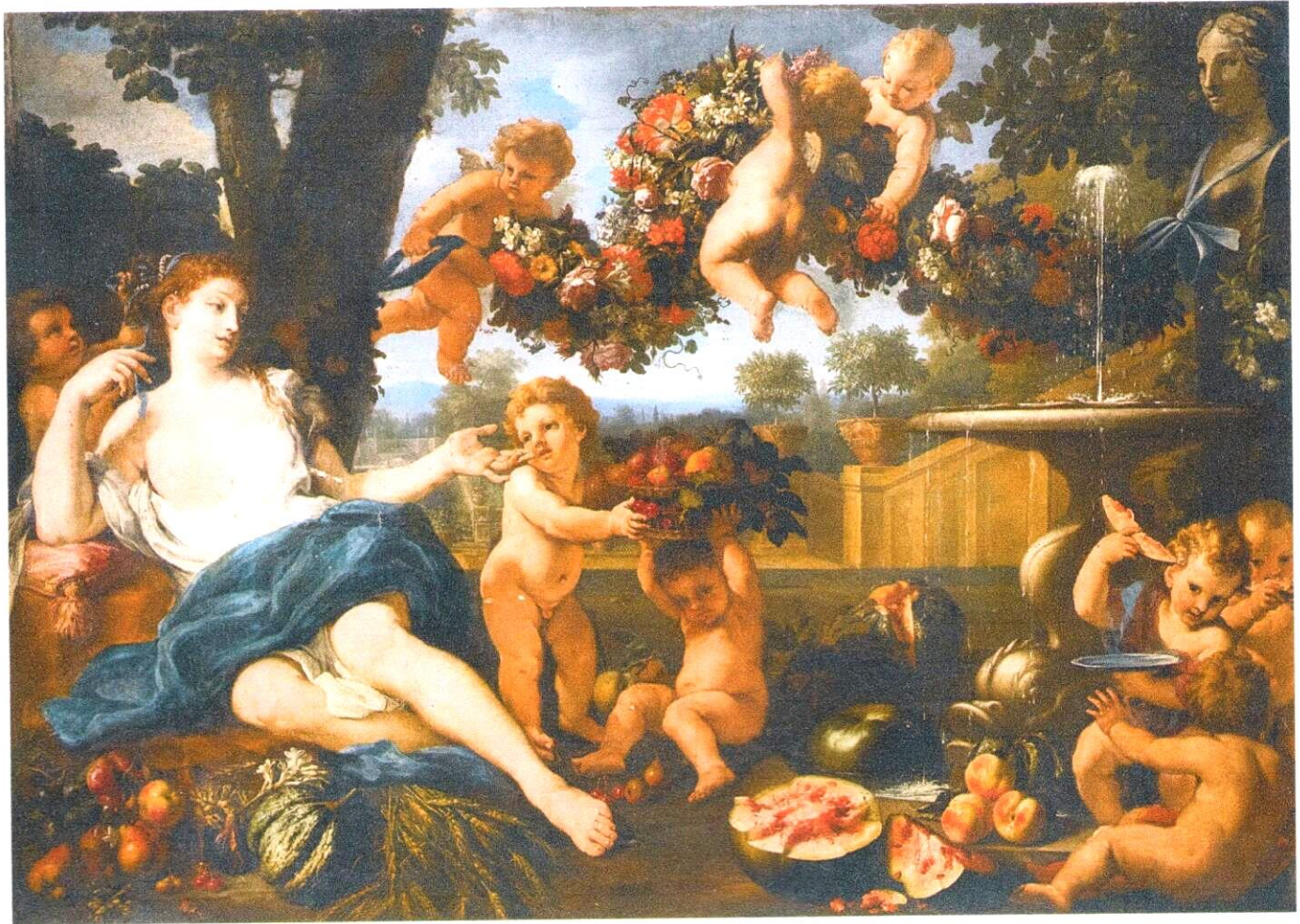


Fig. 10c) Guillaume Courtois and Abraham Breughel, Ceres and Putti at a Fountain, oil on canvas

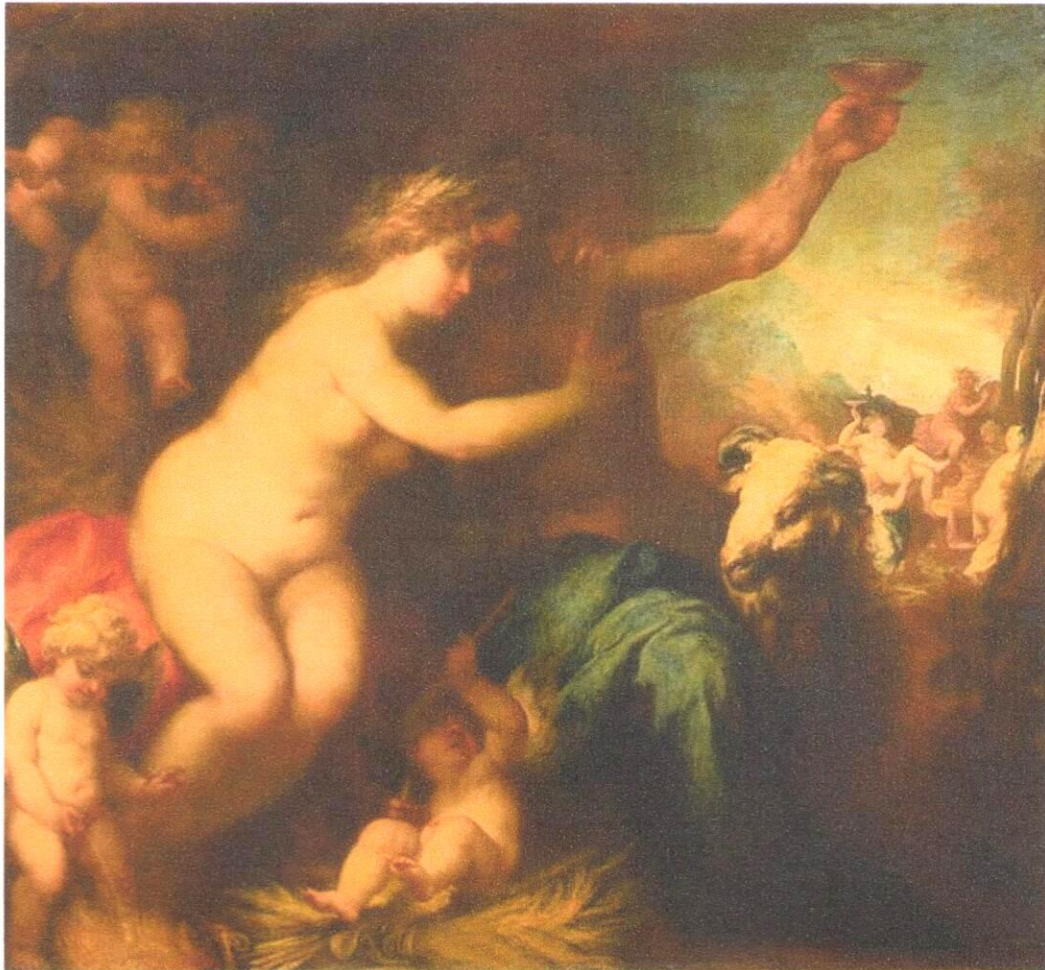


Fig. 11b) Andrea Celesti, Bacchus and Ceres, oil on canvas, Staatlich Kunstsammlungen, Galerie Alte Meister, Dresden
