


Fig. 8b) Ceres, Roman sculpture




Fig. 9) Peter Paul Rubens and Frans Snyders, Roman Statue of Ceres with Cupids, oil on panel, ca. 1615, Hermitage, St. Petersburg




Fig. 10c) Guillaume Courtois and Abraham Breughel, Ceres and Putti at a Fountain, oil on canvas




Fig. 11a) Cornelis Cornelisz, Venus, Bacchus, and Ceres, oil on canvas, 1614, Staatlich Kunstsammlungen, Galerie Alte Meister, Dresden




Fig. 11b) Andrea Celesti, Bacchus and Ceres, oil on canvas, Staatlich Kunstsammlungen, Galerie Alte Meister, Dresden
