


Fig. 3c) Niklaus Stoecklin, Poster for the Travel Bureau of Basel, 1939




Fig. 4a) Niklaus Stoecklin, Houses in Tuscany, oil on canvas, 1920




Fig. 4c) Niklaus Stoecklin, Oasis Near Gabes, Tunisia, oil on board, 1926




Fig. 5a) Niklaus Stoecklin, Vorstellung (Idea), oil on panel, 1920-21, Kunstmuseum Winterthur





Fig. 5d) Niklaus Stoecklin, Woman Without Limbs, oil on board, 1929, private collection




Fig. 5g) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Peach and Rock Crystal, oil on cardboard, 1917.




Fig. 6c) Georg Schrimpf, Still Life with Cat, oil on canvas, 1923, Bayerische Sammlung Moderne Kunst, Munich




Fig. 8b) Wilhelm Schmid, Flowering Artichokes in a Vase, oil on wood, 1926




Fig. 8c) Fritz Paravicini, Pussy Willow Branch by a Window, oil on canvas, ca. 1930




Fig. 8d) François Barraud, Still Life with Plant and Ceramic Horse, 1930




Fig. 9) Niklaus Stoecklin, Paris Window, oil on canvas, 1931, private collection




Fig. 10a) Niklaus Stoecklin, Lilies in a Blue Vase, oil on canvas, 1926




Fig. 10c) Niklaus Stoecklin, Onions, oil on canvas, 1939





Fig. 10g) Niklaus Stoecklin, Melon on a Faience Plate, oil on board, 1952
