




Fig. 11c) Heinrich "Haigge" Müller, Still Life with Madonna, oil on canvas




Fig. 13a) Jan Jansz van de Velde, III, Still Life with Roemer and Fruit, 1656, private collection




Fig. 14a) Jean-Etienne Liotard, Still Life with Fruit, pastel, 1782, Musée d'Art, Geneva




Fig. 15c) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Blue Bird, oil on board, 1932, private collection




Fig. 15e) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life in White, oil on canvas, 1937, Private Collection, Switzerland




Fig. 15f) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Lemon, Juicer, and Knife, oil on canvas, 1942, Kunstmuseum, Winterthur

Fig. 15g) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Shell and Horn, oil on canvas, 1942, Kunstmuseum Winterthur




Fig. 16a) Niklaus Stoecklin, Pansies in a Vase, oil on board, 1946




Fig. 18) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Yellow Dog, oil on panel, 1925, private collection




Fig. 19) Heinrich "Haggie" Müller, Still Life with Porcelain Dog, oil on canvas, 1954




Fig. 20) Niklaus Stoecklin, Still Life with Porcelain Pitcher
